We therefore ask that students to approach this contact with any enquiries they have, without involving third parties.
- Queries and problems relating to the thesis topic, suggested theoreticians, the method of research or the development of analysis must be directed to the student's own thesis supervisor.
- Data collection, drafting of indexes and bibliography as well as editing of the text must be carried out independently by the student under the close supervision of their supervisor. The Peggy Guggenheim Collection reserves the right to view the text before printing, to indicate errors and, if necessary, make corrections to content that involves the museum directly.

- The Peggy Guggenheim Collection favours research projects that have a specific focus, rather than generic presentations on the museum and the foundation, several of which have already been done.
