A series of talks with artists in their studios

As part of membership programming for the Peggy Guggenheim Collection, on March 1st we will begin a series of talks curated by Giovanni Bianchi, Lecturer in History of Contemporary Art at the University of Venice, Ca' Foscari. In these talks, we will meet three artists representative of three generations present in Venice: young artists, as selected by the Fondazione Bevilacqua La Masa; the middle-aged artist, represented by Maria Teresa Sartori; and the mature artist, represented by the American Lawrence Carroll.

Before these artists speak in their studios, there will be an introductory lecture at the Peggy Guggenheim Collection.
